One of the easiest ways to speed up grading papers is to collect the students work in alphabetical order. I assign each student a number on the first day of school and they are numbered in alphabetical order. When I'm ready to collect papers, I simply call out the students numbers in order - 1, 2, 3, etc.

Communicate your expectations clearly. Discuss the grading rubric with students, provide them with writing and referencing guides, or hand out samples of poor, adequate, and excellent responses. Whichever method you choose, make sure your students have a good understanding of what you're going to be grading for.

Here is a way to be fair and fast, based on my experience and long years of experimentation. Draw small (2x3 or 3x5) rectangles, and insist that answer must fit within the borders of the rectangle. Grade the test one question at a time, rather than one student's paper at a time. Grade in multiple fast passes.
