There are three types of the study of the sounds of language. Acoustic Phonetics is the study of the physical properties of sounds. Auditory Phonetics is the study of the way listeners perceive sounds.

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Articulatory Phonetics is the study of how the vocal tracts produce the sounds. This article will only describe articulatory phonetics.

## **What is Phonetics? - Introduction to Linguistics ...**

Languages use both voice and the lack of it in the production of speech sounds.

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If the vocal cords vibrate while the given speech sound is articulated, the sound is voiced; if not, it's voiceless. This second stage of sound production— whether voice is produced in the larynx or not — is called the phonation process.

Natural languages rarely have perfectly phonemic orthographies; a high degree of grapheme-phoneme correspondence can be expected in orthographies based on alphabetic writing systems, but they differ in how ...
