To make it easier to understand how you can monitor SNMP traps, let's look at a real-world example: the NetGuardian 832A. This RTU sends SNMP traps based on many inputs. Typically, the 832A will send traps to your manager when one of its 32 discrete alarm inputs is triggered by a contact closure output from one of your devices. This could indicate anything from generator failure to a door open, to a motion sensor.

How to Configure Your Appliance to Send SNMP Trap ...

As a follow up to my post last week, I learned that you can use Windows to send an SNMP trap. The functionality is built into windows, as long as you have enabled SNMP via computer management (in Windows 2008 R2 and later). Once enabled in features, you can open the menu to configure SNMP by running the following command at the run menu:

Please log into the switch and type in the following command: "configure snmp add trapreceiver community " If no SNMP trap receiver is configured, EXOS will not send traps. Use command "show configuration snmp" and "show management" output to see the trap receiver is configured.

SNMP requests are required for discovery and topology changes. In addition, a managed device agent can not send a trap, if the device has had a catastrophic outage. SNMPv1 traps are defined in RFC 1157, with these fields: Enterprise —Identifies the type of managed object that generates the trap.

You can configure the router to forward syslog messages to your network management server as SNMP traps instead of syslog packets with the following configuration commands: Router#configure terminal. Enter configuration commands, one per line.

How to send EventLog entries as SNMP Traps with ...

There are two modes of operation with SNMP - get requests (or polling) where one device requests information from an SNMP enabled device on a regular basis (normally using UDP port 161), and traps where the SNMP enabled device sends a message to another device when an event occurs (normally using UDP port 162).

SNMP traps offer an alternative if there is an SNMP server available. This is a useful tool to send specific messages for troubleshooting or monitoring purposes. For example, if there is a relevant problem that has to be tracked down during failover scenarios, SNMP traps for class ha on both FTD and ASA can be used to focus on those messages only.

As from Control-M side the SNMP sending configuration is done, the final step is to test by sending an alert to the alert window with a failing test job for example Check if the central monitoring server is receiving the trap (synchronize with the monitoring application administrator).

Zenoss will accept SNMP traps from your devices as soon as you configure those devices to send traps to your Zenoss server. The zentrap daemon will listen to the standard SNMP trap port of 162/udp and create an event for every trap that it receives.

2.3 Sending a test SNMP Trap The easiest way to create a SNMP Trap for testing now is use the "Send Syslog Test Message" from the Configuration Client tools menu. If you configured filters, don't forget to set the correct syslog facility and priority.

Make sure you create SNMP Generic Trap monitor exactly for the host you expect sending traps from. Pay attention to its IP
